Crossover Subsidy Eligibility

- ✓ The installed crossover must have prior approval by the City and comply with the City's Crossover Guidelines and Technical Specifications.
- ✓ The subsidy must be applied for within 12 months of the crossover installation.
- ✓ A crossover subsidy can only be claimed by the property owner(s).
- ✓ A subsidy can only be paid once per property (and normally relates to the first crossover to service the property).
- ✓ A copy of materials delivery docket(s) and/or invoice(s) indicating the type of material and quantity used may be required as evidence to support the application.

Crossover Subsidy Calculation and Payment

- ✓ Subsidy payments are not based on the rates charged by the engaged contractor.
- ✓ The \$ amounts used to calculate subsidies change in line with the City's approved Fees and Charges.
- ✓ Approved subsidies will be calculated using the formula below -
 - Length of the crossover in metres (from kerb to property boundary) x 3m (width of a standard crossover) x current \$ amount per metre² of plain grey concrete at 100mm thick
 - Plus
 - Current \$ amount, based on area, for each splay (wing) installed
 - This total is then divided by 2
- ✓ Approved subsidy payments will be paid either by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) or by cheque directly to the property owner(s) as noted on this form.
